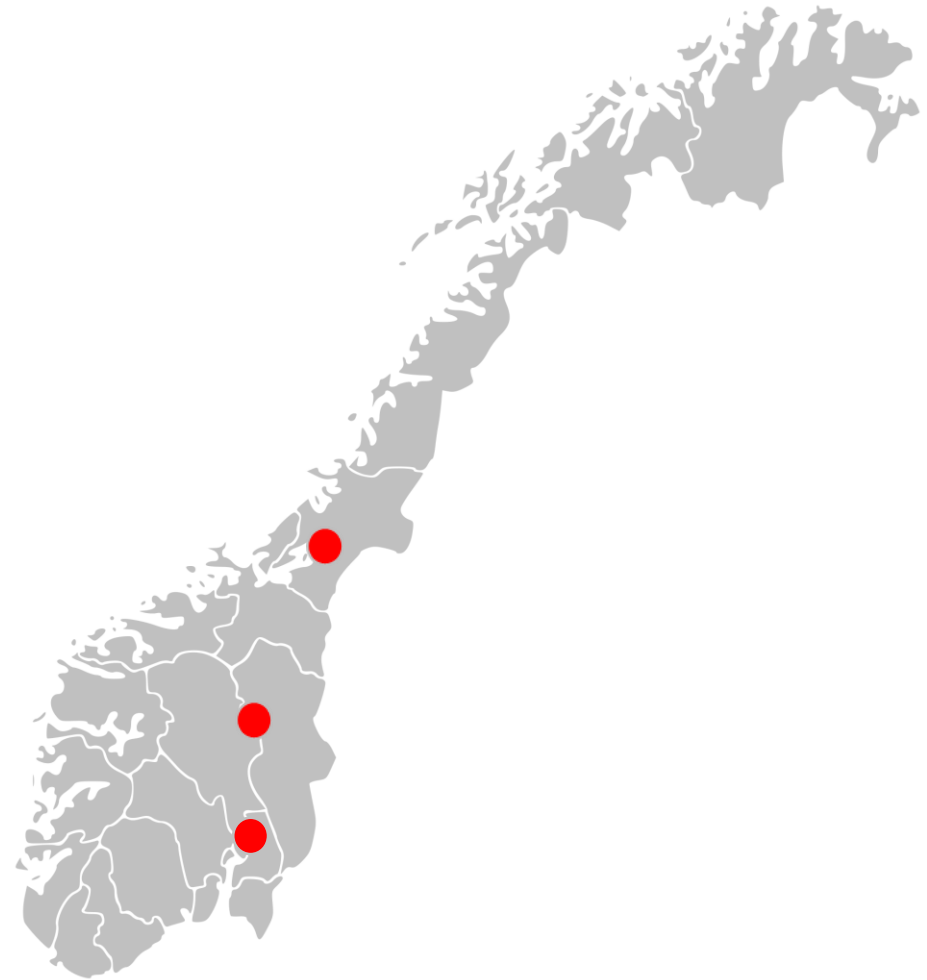

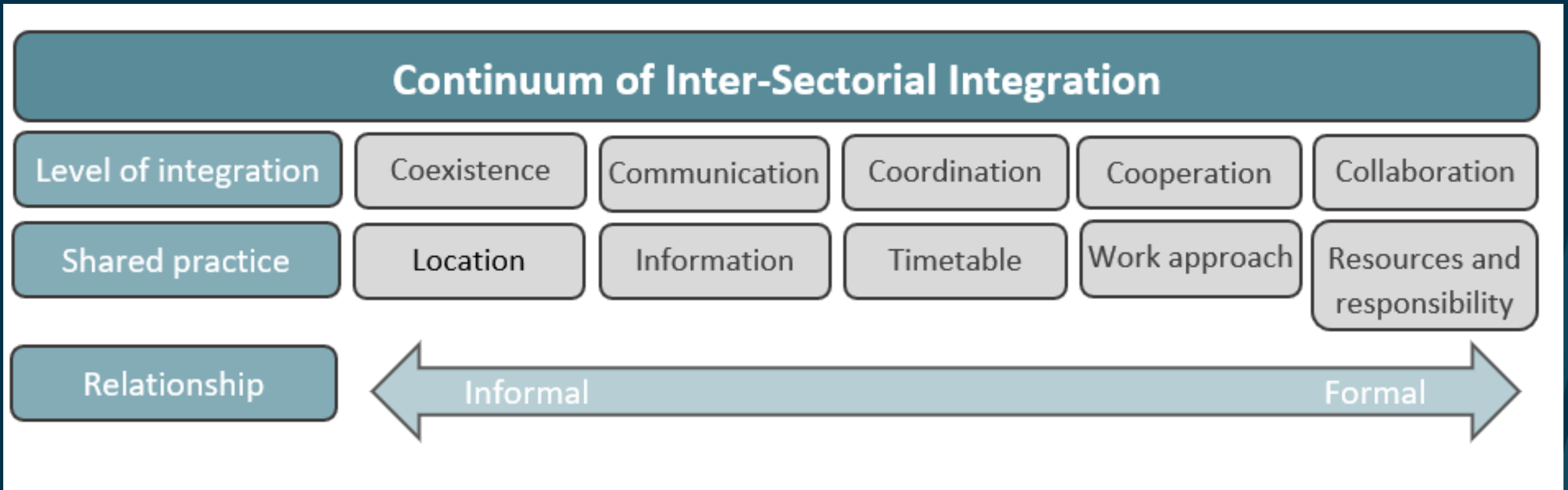
Demographic variation

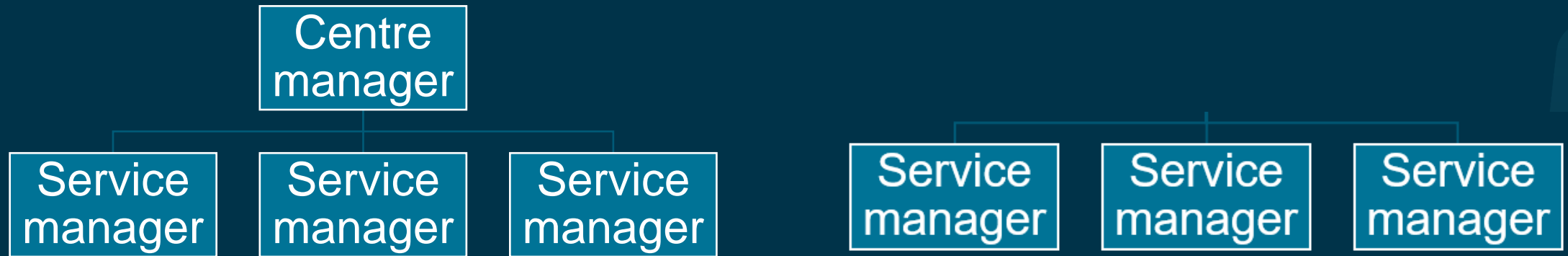

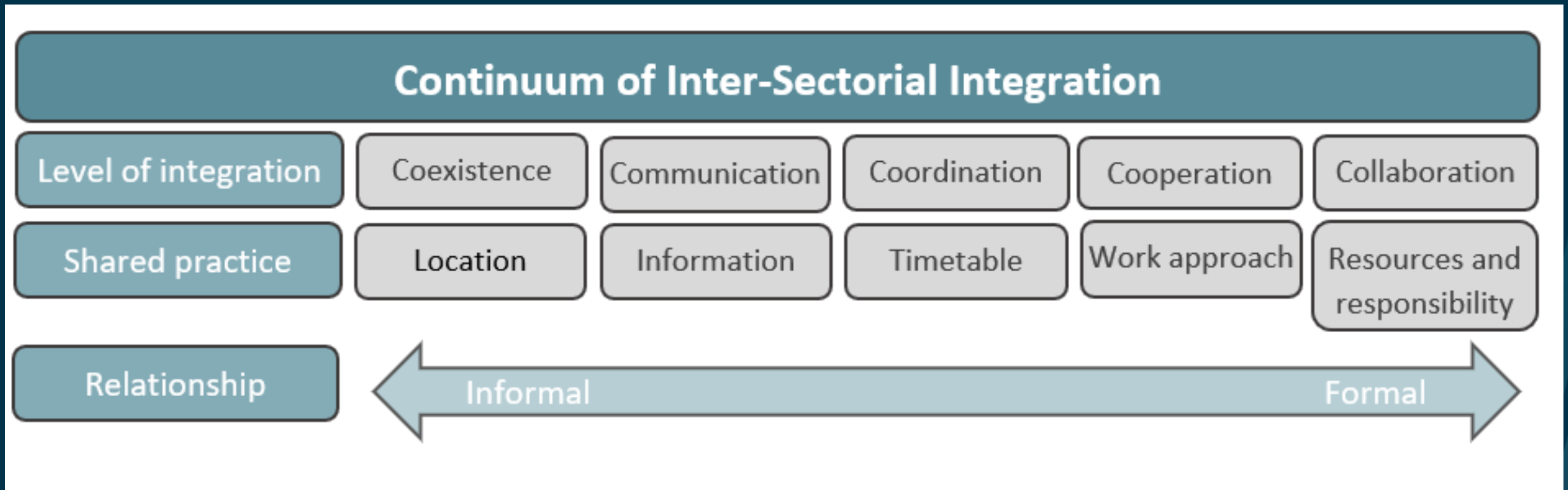


Continuum of Intersectorial intergration, adopted from Boston and Gill's (2011) model of inter-Govermental Intergration.
