Municipal Family Assistance Center

The Torun Municipal Family Assistance Center (MOPR) organizes activities aimed at helping people and families in difficult life situations.

The activity of the center is financed from the own funds of the commune and from the state budget. It also is financed from external funds, including the funds of the European Union.

Situations in which assistance is provided

Poverty

Orphanhood

Assistance in the adaptation of young people leaving care and training centers

The main objectives of the MOPR:

- carrying out activities aimed at helping to create a favorable living environment for people seeking help.
- helping people in difficult life situations that they cannot overcome without outside help;
- assistance to the child and family in need of social assistance;
- providing opportunities for people with disabilities to participate in public life.

Departments

The activity of Department of Family and Children's Aid:

- Assistance to foster families and assistance in transferring a child to a foster family, arranging meetings with the biological parents of children from foster families, assessment of foster families, referral to training future foster parents
- Assessment and determination of expenses for the needs of the adopted child
- Assistance in continuing education for people who have left the foster family
- Providing accommodation in a social care home
- Implementation of assistance to the child in a situation where it is not possible to transfer a child in a foster family.
- Assistance in finding a job, obtaining housing, providing legal and psychological assistance
- Strengthening the role and functions of the family, helping to develop care and education skills, promoting family integration, promoting family reintegration when children are in a foster family.

Family in the center

(implementation years: 2014-2020)

The main objective of the project is to expand access to specialized family support services and foster families to create a single integrated family assistance system in the Kuyavian-Pomorskie voivodship.

**Support for the employment of
 caregivers in the territory of Torun
 (implementation time 01/01/2017. -
 30.06.2018)**

The aim of the project was to increase the professional activity of 80 people who performed the functions of caring for children under the age of 3 years.



“We support mothers”

The goal of the project is to increase the professional activity of 200 people caring for children under the age of 3 years and to support them in returning to the labor market by financing the care of children under the age of 3 years for 12 months.

“Strength in the family”

(implementation years 2014-2020)

The goal of the project is to increase access to family support and foster families by creating two care centers for children aged 6 to 18 and a Torun club for families, providing support to families.
